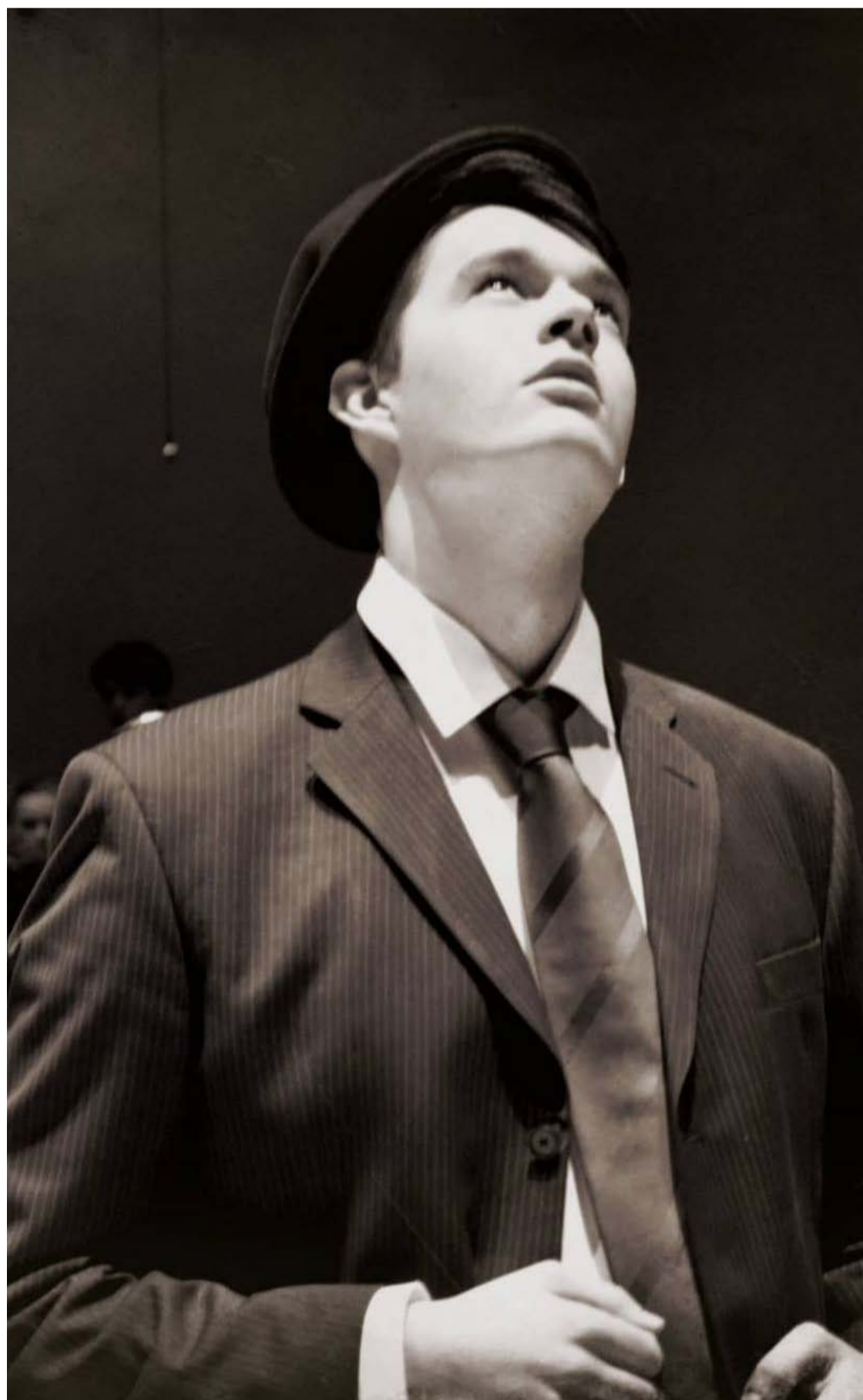

Gediminas Plesnys

Lithuanian violinist Gediminas Plesnys began playing the violin at the age of five. His talent and love for music appeared at very young age when he started his studies at the National M.K.Čiurlionis School of Arts in Vilnius. During the studies he participated in multiple concerts with school symphony orchestra, gave solo recitals in various cities of Lithuania, performed in large venues, including Vilnius and Kaunas philharmonics. Participated in classical music projects, festivals: 20th international festival of young musicians "Kaunas 2011" (in Kaunas state Philharmonic Hall), artistic project with chamber orchestra of Šiauliai in concert series "Muzikiniai Rudenys 2011". Gediminas has received numerous awards, diplomas, special prizes and the highest awards from the regional and international competitions, also he regularly attends Master classes, workshops and summer academies all around the Europe with eminent violinists including prof. Petru Munteanu, Boris Garlitsky, Alexander Gilman, Andrey Baranov, Lynn Chang and Pavel Berman. Gediminas is currently enrolled in the Bachelor studies in The University of Applied Sciences and Arts of Southern Switzerland. Since 2014 he has been studying violin at Conservatorio della Svizzera italiana with Professor Pavel Berman attending the Bachelor of Arts in Music and actively continues giving concerts in solo, chamber and symphonic settings.
